

## Latest Roof update

I will continue to update the school community on the roof through our regular newsletter updates. The next phase of work will be during the Easter holidays when the 3 classrooms that are currently sealed off will have

complete building surveys completed on them and work will start to strip out these rooms.

The time frame for the section of the roof to be replaced is still scheduled for the summer holidays with the classrooms being refitted and available to use again in the new sessions 2025/26. I will update on this after the holidays.
